Eventing – sometime described as an Equestrian triathlon – is the most complete combined Equestrian discipline with three phases of competition, all contested on the same horse, on consecutive days.

Penalties can be incurred in all phases with the aim to have as few penalties as possible at the end of the competition.

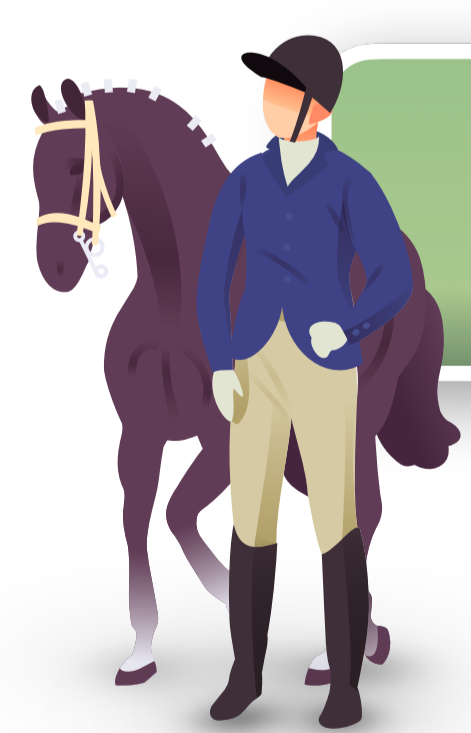
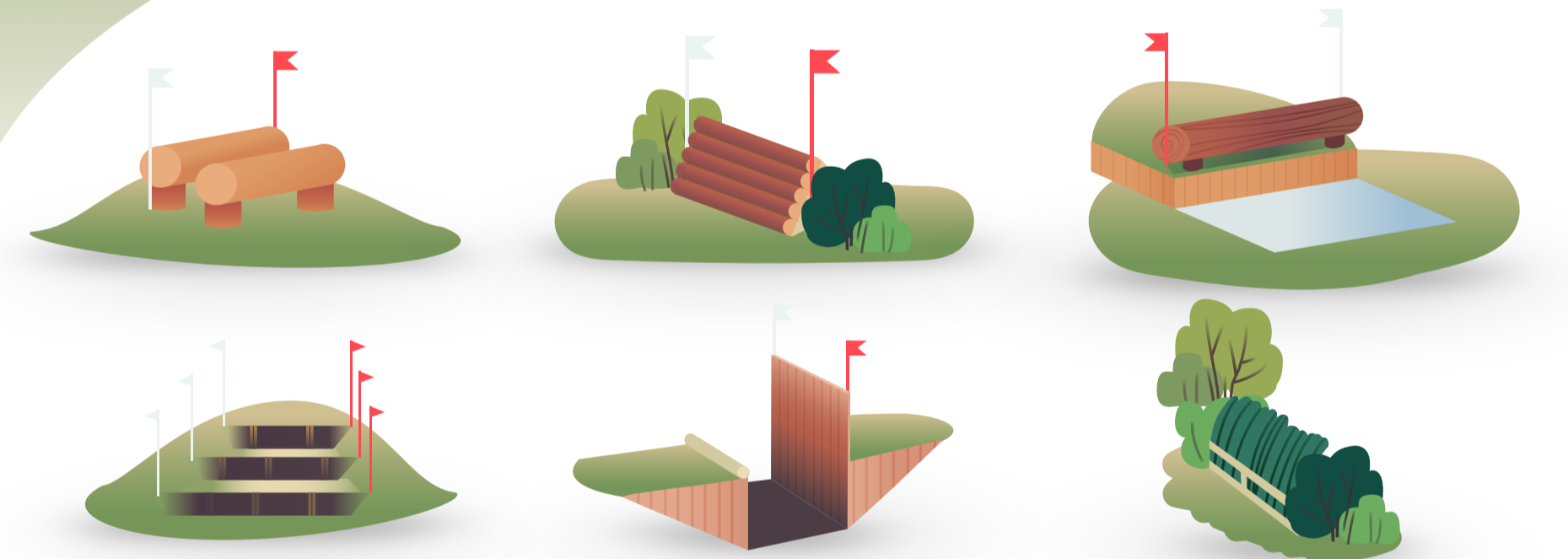

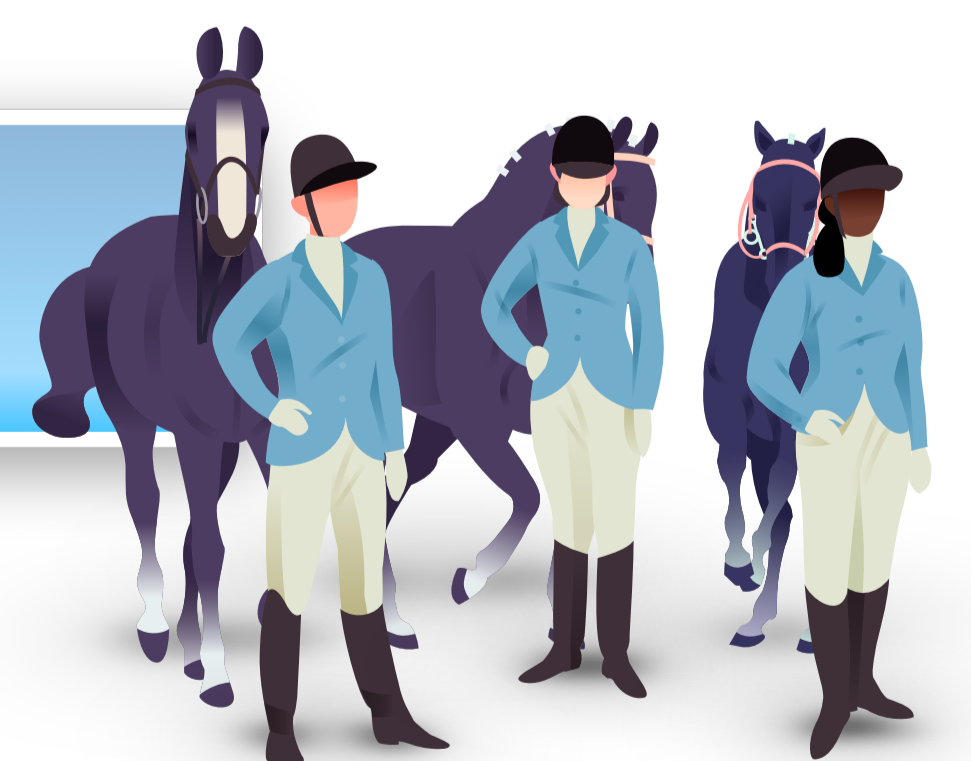
